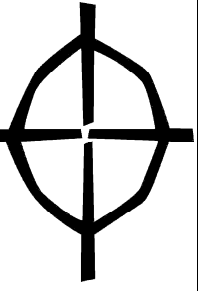

## MUSIC AT BRADFORD CATHEDRAL

---

Bradford, the birthplace of Delius, is still a place of music. In Victorian times local choral societies, church choirs and brass bands were founded, many of which continue to flourish. The solid Victorian buildings of Bradford are still decorated with exuberant detail - there is music even in the stones of this city. Increasingly, the annual Bradford Festival brings out our hidden music onto the streets for all to enjoy. The music of many cultures and traditions expresses the vitality of this immensely varied city.

Bradford Cathedral has long been a part of Bradford's musical heritage: as early as the 1840s the Church Choral Society was giving performances. That tradition is now stronger than ever with a thriving Cathedral Choir, comprised of separate top lines of boys and girls who sing together with committed volunteer Lay Clerks. The repertoire is varied and the standards are high. In recent months, the Choir has been involved with two BBC Radio 2 Sunday Half Hour broadcasts and in a live broadcast of BBC Radio 4 Sunday Worship.
